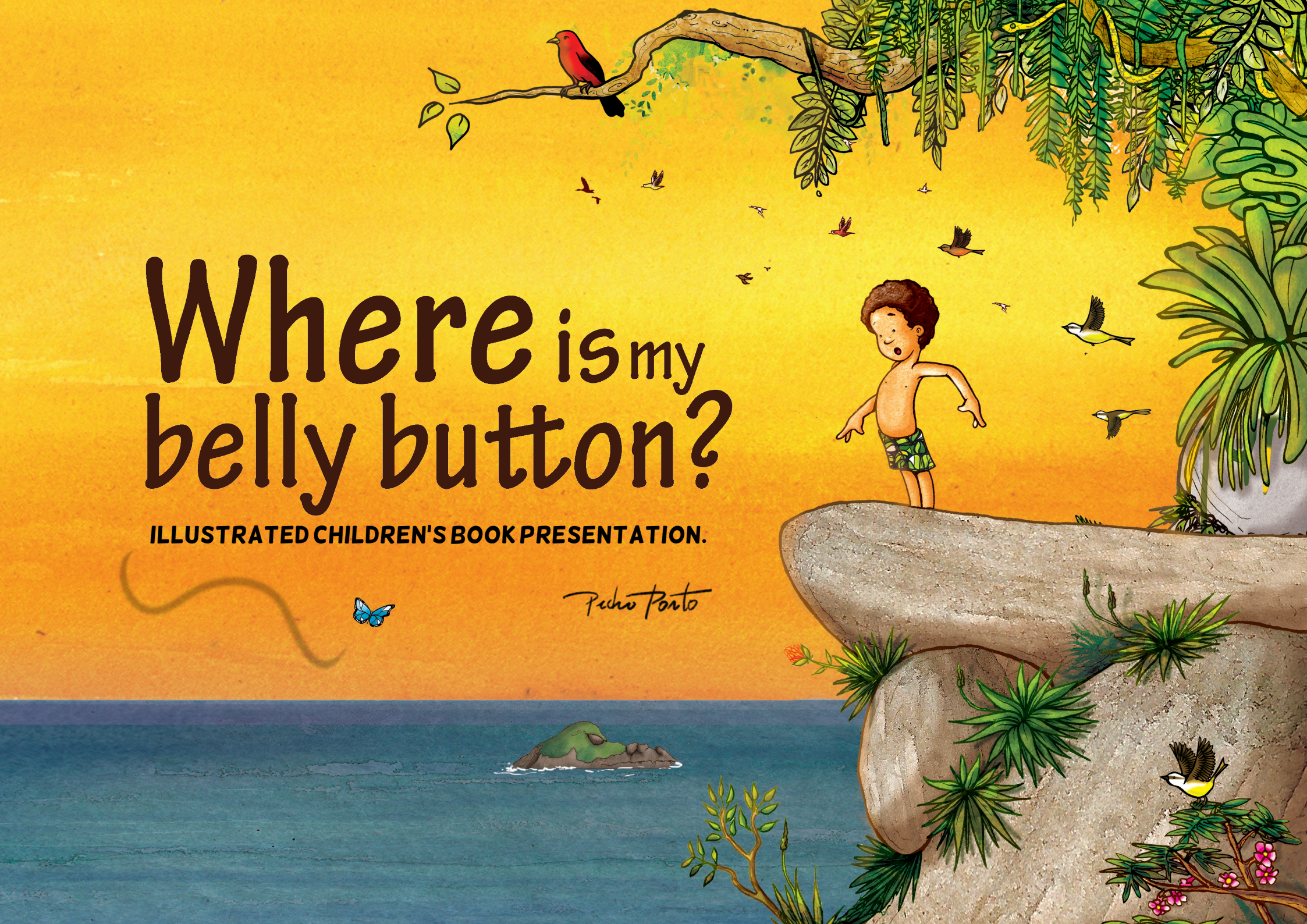

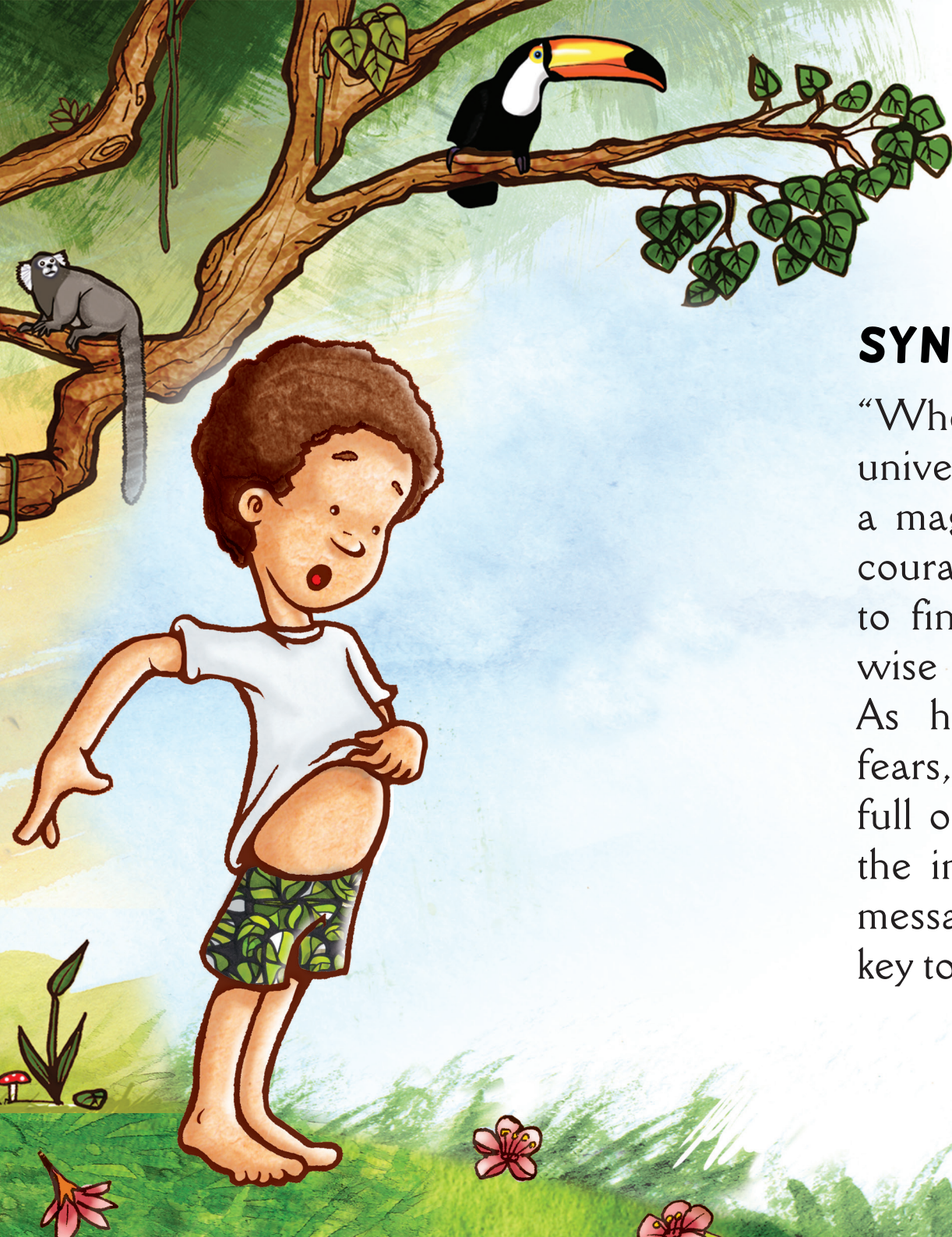




Where is my belly button?
